

Proceedings of the meeting for Common Online Admission System into PG Courses under the project Student Academic Management System (SAMS) from the academic session 2019-20.

A meeting was held in the office chamber of Vice-Chairperson, OSHEC for common online admission into Post Graduates (PG) Courses of all state universities under the project Student Academic Management System (SAMS) from the academic session 2019-20 on 05-Dec-2018 at 11:00 A.M. The list of members present in the meeting is annexed.

At the outset, the Vice-Chairperson welcomed the members and sought views from the members present (Annexure-A) regarding the common online admission for PG courses in state universities.

After threadbare discussion, the following decisions were taken for smooth & timely implementation of the above said program for ensuing Academic Session 2019-20.

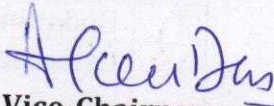
- 1) The members welcomed the initiative and said it would be a cost effective and transparent common online PG admission for students. They also agreed to start from the academic session 2019-20 in all state universities and autonomous colleges with P.G. Courses. In this regard, necessary communication may be made to OCAC for initiation of the system study to know the PG admission process as soon as possible for development of the application.
- 2) In brief, following activities has been decided to be done by the different stakeholders

- 3) Students will be selected in the combination of their career and entrance examination mark. Career mark shall be calculated from 30 marks i.e. 5% for 10th or equivalent courses, 10% for 12th or equivalent courses and 15% for the Degree or equivalent courses, whereas 70 marks will be purely calculated on the entrance examination mark.
- 4) The online process will be preparing the statewide merit list only. Universities will be responsible to continue with their admission process based on this merit list.
- 5) Entrance Test shall be OMR based. At least two (02) sets of question papers for each subject shall be prepared. 30 questions from UG generic course syllabus and

- 40 questions from the core syllabus. The examination will be conducted with a time duration of 75 minutes(1 hr 15 minutes) for 70 questions.
- 6) Subjects that are unique to a particular university, would be tackled by the concerned university.
 - 7) Self financed or PPP mode courses are not part of this common entrance examination.
 - 8) Autonomous colleges that have PG courses in the approved subjects will also admit from the common merit list.
 - 9) The common entrance examination for the academic session 2019-20 shall be conducted by Utkal / Berhampur/ Sambalpur University. For this, Utkal University will prepare the common entrance examination question for PG courses of Art & Social science Stream. Similarly, Berhampur and Sambalpur University will prepare common entrance examination question for PG courses of Commerce-business and Science stream respectively.
 - 10) There will be remuneration of Rs 100/- for each question setting. After the preparation of question, each set will be moderated by subject experts and subject experts may be pulled from other Universities.
 - 11) Questions of some specific subjects, which are unique to a particular University will be prepared by Professors of the respective universities only and will be shared with the Universities, assigned for conducting the examinations.
 - 12) It was agreed that the Apex Admission Committee will have Vice Chancellors of the three universities conducting examinations, VC OSHEC and Member Secretary OSHEC as Members.
 - 13) As this activity is expected to bring better equity in to the PG admission system and upgrade quality of governance, the universities can be provided assistance from OHEPEE to compensate for revenue loss from admission fees.
 - 14) The matter is to be taken up for concurrence at the VC meeting on Dec 6, 2018

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair & the members present.

(Name of the University) invites Applications from Retired Faculties as NAAC Experts under Odisha Higher Education Program for Excellence and Equity (OHEPEE)

(Name of the University) is implementing the "Odisha Higher Education Program for Excellence and Equity" (OHEPEE) during FY 2017-2022 with support from the World Bank that aims at system reforms in the higher education sector in the state. The objective of OHEPEE is to improve quality of students' education, equitable access to selected higher education institutions and improved governance of the higher education system in the state.

One of the important objectives of the program is to increase the percentage of colleges with NAAC accreditation and for colleges going into subsequent cycles, improve the NAAC grade from the previous cycle of accreditation.

Now the project invites application in the prescribed format (Annexure-1) from interested retired faculties for facilitating Colleges having no NAAC at present to apply for the same. The main objective of engaging NAAC Experts is to mentor, help and extend handholding support to the Colleges having no NAAC / NAAC nearing expiry to apply for NAAC and get accredited.

The individuals will be selected and engaged on the basis of their qualifications and work experience for the assignment. Based on the qualifications, if more than required numbers apply, top ranked individuals will be shortlisted for interview.

One NAAC Expert is to mentor 15 to 20 colleges. Applications from eligible are invited in the enclosed proforma (Annexure-1) along with self-attested copies of the certificates of essential qualifications and experience. The completed applications in hard copy and soft is to be addressed to (Concerned University Authority) and mailed to (email id). Applications received incomplete or after the due date will not be considered. Only shortlisted candidates will be intimated and called for the interview.

Last date of submission of application:

Applications can only be received through Registered Post/Speed Post, super scribing on the sealed envelope "Application for NAAC Expert" and also, while submitting on-line through email to () mention in the subject "Application for NAAC Experts".

Key Responsibilities: S/He will be overall responsible for mentoring the assigned Colleges to apply NAAC and get accredited. Key responsibilities are as follows:

- Training the select faculties of the assigned Colleges for successful NAAC application,
- Guiding the assigned Colleges on the procedural details, mandatory requirements, and documents required,
- Helping the assigned Colleges to undergo online submission of NAAC application,

- Helping the assigned Colleges in the documentation of IIQA (Institutional Information for Quality Assessment),
- Complete documentation of Self Study Report (SSR) for the assigned Colleges,
- Preparing the assigned Colleges for Peer Team Visit with specialized training for all the stakeholders in the assigned Colleges so that the Colleges can handle in confidence all the parameters of on site visit by Peer Team Members,
- Having a time bound approach in preparing and applying, and
- Any other responsibility may be assigned by the State Project Director in this regard.

Key Qualification:

- Teaching experience of more than 20 years in College/ University
- Enlisted as NAAC Assessor and experience as NAAC Assessor in at least one College/ University
- Excellent communication and facilitation skills.

Selection Process: For selecting the best candidates, the applications will be shortlisted based on educational qualifications and work experience, and final interview of the shortlisted candidates to select the desired number of NAAC Experts.

Remuneration: Remuneration for the NAAC Expert is Rs. 25,000/- per College including travel expense and local accommodation for field visit to the respective colleges. Thus, total remuneration will be based on number of Colleges assigned to a particular NAAC Expert. Payment to the NAAC Experts will be on as below

Updation of IIQA and its NAAC acceptance – 20%
 Updation of SSR and its NAAC acceptance – 40%
 Award of accreditation above 1.5 out of 4 – 40%

Payment to the NAAC Experts will be made to their Bank account directly on submission of application stating the achievement of benchmarks.
