

The present research examines the surrender of Naxalites in Odisha, a state that has become a significant focus in the Red Corridor due to the ongoing Naxal war in India. It focuses on the fate of those who surrendered before the state. examining the motivations behind their involvement in Ultra Leftist Insurgency and their post-surrender life.
